The frogTerminal also supports simultaneous registration with multiple SIP servers and connection to smartphones via the SIP-enabled frogCloud. Our optional frogSIP app runs on Grandstream® devices as well as on mobiles, allowing remote configuration of the frogTerminal and retrieval of access logs with video.

frogblue's standard modules ("frogs") integrate seamlessly with Bluetooth Mesh enabling control of lighting, doors, and other building systems, while also capturing input from sensors like temperature probes, emergency buttons, and door/window contacts.

Connect frogTerminal and multiple Grandstream® IP phones via a standard network switch - no SIP server or cloud connection required. For flexible configurations, you can register the Terminal with multiple SIP servers at once to make multi-party environments even easier.

Smartphone via frogCloud and the frogSIP app

Download the free frogSIP app from the Apple® App Store or Google® Play. Simply scan a QR code or enter a PIN token to pair your smartphone with the system. The app displays missed calls, call and event history (with video), and lets you define access codes and function PINs for triggering actions by the frogTerminal.

Interconnected Locations

Install the frogSIP app on Android-based Grandstream® phones to unlock the full feature set, and connect the devices to the SIP-enabled frogCloud to link multiple locations securely over the internet.

Decentralized Access Control

The frogTerminal intercom supports RFID transponders (Desfire EV2) with time schedules, additional PIN codes, and door zone management. User access data is stored and updated directly on the transponder, enabling decentralized distribution across intercoms. This means no pre-registration is required at each terminal – simply use the transponder to gain access. Even during network outages, access remains fully functional – thanks to the decentralized architecture.

Three-Factor Authentication

Configure the frogTerminal by time schedule or user role to require a transponder, PIN, and voice or video call verification – ideal for access outside of working hours.

Hires Video Snapshot Recording

Every event can trigger storage of video clips and high-resolution stills for later review and analysis.


